- Dave and Ronda Jones, two SkillsUSA Utah volunteers, will be driving a pickup truck and towing our SkillsUSA Utah equipment trailer to Atlanta to transport conference materials, toolboxes, computers, and other required contest equipment that cannot be a carry-on or checked baggage on commercial aircraft. We will **NOT** transport participants' extra luggage or clothing in this trailer.
- If you or your student will be bringing items to place in the equipment trailer, <u>please email me at skillsusa.utahstatedirector@gmail.com</u> or text me at 435-590-8386 with your name, school and a <u>list of all trailer items by June 7th to inform me of your intention to bring tools and/or equipment to the trailer.</u>
- The equipment trailer will leave Cedar City at 8 a.m. on Wednesday, June 14th. If there are any trailer items from southern Utah schools, they need to be delivered to me, Richard Wittwer, at 4318 West 1275 South, Cedar City, Utah 84720, by 8 pm on Monday, June 12, 2023. Please coordinate with other local school advisors to make one drop-off trip to Cedar City.
- For eastern Utah and Utah county schools, I will gladly meet any school representatives at one of the I-15 exits during my trip north the morning of Wednesday, June 14th. Please contact me by email or phone to make these special arrangements. I must be at the SLCC campus by 1:00 p.m.
- On Wednesday, June 14th from 1 p.m. 4 p.m., the trailer will be at the Salt Lake Community College main campus parking lot located north of the Lifetime Activities Center or LAC, where we held the state conference awards program. This SLCC campus is located at 4600 South Redwood Road, Salt Lake City, Utah, 84123. The LAC is located at the west end of this campus. If I am not present when you arrive, call me at 435-590-8386.
- On Wednesday evening, June 14th, the trailer will be at the Davis Technical College parking lot from 5 p.m. 6:30 p.m., if there are any Davis or Weber County schools that need to put items in the trailer.
- The trailer will leave Salt Lake City at 8 am on Thursday, June 15, destined for Atlanta.
- Special Note #1: The heaviest tools and equipment must be placed in the front of the trailer. If you have heavy tools or materials, please arrive early in the drop-off scheduled times.
- Special Note #2: A properly completed and signed liability release document must be emailed to skillsusa.utahstatedirector@gmail.com, or presented to me when you drop off your tools and equipment. A copy of the current trailer liability release can be found on the utahskillsusa.org website NLSC page.
- The truck and equipment trailer will depart from Atlanta at 6 am on Saturday, June 24th. All tools and equipment must be in the trailer by 11 pm on Friday, June 23rd. Trailer items must be properly prepared for the return trip and brought to the Utah headquarters Juniper room by 3 p.m. on Friday, June 23rd. Heavy items must be placed in the front of the trailer first.
- The trailer is scheduled to be in Salt Lake City in the late afternoon of Monday, June 26th. Prizes, tools and equipment will be available for pickup that same day, from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. at the Salt Lake Community College Lifetime Activities Center, the same location as the drop-off prior to the conference. All Weber County, Davis County, Salt Lake area and Utah County schools must come to the SLCC location to collect their trailer items. If necessary, I will make special arrangements to connect with eastern Utah schools, possibly Monday evening from 7 p.m. 8 p.m. at the Costco parking lot in Spanish Fork.
- Shortly thereafter, the trailer and all unclaimed items will travel to Cedar City and be placed in a storage unit. You will have to make special arrangements to pick them up there. I will not pay for any shipping costs.
