*******IMPORTANT UPDATES OF CONTEST SCHEDULE*******

In the last couple of years, the SkillsUSA Awards Ceremony had many delays and undesirable outcomes due to logistics and scoring processes. Due to these problems, the scoring demands have changed for the contests. Scores are now due by 1 pm on Friday March 29th. The previous contest schedule completed contest and scoring around 5pm on Friday, which does not meet deadline. To accomplish this new deadline, **the contest has been moved up to the beginning of Thursday March 28th at 8am sharp.** The schedule is for **secondary and post-secondary (College) groups.** Orientation for both groups will be held at 8am.
