Special Note #2: A properly completed and signed liability release document must be submitted when you drop off your tools and equipment. The liability release document can be found on the state website national conference page.

The tool truck and trailer will return from Louisville late on Monday, July 2nd. Prizes, tools and equipment will be available for pickup on Tuesday, July 3rd from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm at the SLCC Meadowbrook campus, located at 3900 South 250 West, Building "B". Drive into the compound between Building B and Building C and look for the open door. Mark Kranendonk will be volunteering his summer break personal time to supervise the distribution of items, so make sure you meet the scheduled time limits.

All unclaimed items will travel to Cedar City and you will have to make arrangements to pick them up there. We will not pay for any shipping costs.
